INTRODUCTION 1.0

- CSOs must have a proven track record in project management and facilitation of
- service delivery on a large scale, preferably from government interventions or multilateral and bilateral organizations and NGOs in Nigeria; CSOs should possess necessary qualifications, skills, and experience in monitoring and
- evaluation, good governance, citizen engagement, and social accountability;
- National Lead CSOs must demonstrate a minimum of 5 years of operational presence,
- while Zonal Level CSOs should demonstrate 2 years of operational presence and experience in at least 2 states within their zone of interest; CSOs must be registered with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC, other relevant
- bodies) as NGO/CSO and have been in existence/actively operating for a minimum of 5 years:-with clarity on Tax Clearance, Audited Account, Annual Turnover, etc; and g. Experience working in hard-to-reach areas and capacity for national coverage.
